- Genesis to Samuel

David

- Samuel sent to Jesse by God. "...for I have provided me a king among his sons." 1 Samuel 16:1
- "...the Lord looketh on the heart." 16:7
- David's characteristics
 - Youngest, kept sheep 16:11
 - Ruddy, beautiful countenance, goodly to look to, Lord's choice 16:12
 - Cunning in playing, mighty valiant man, man of war, prudent in matters, comely person, Lord is with him 16:18
- Saul loved him greatly initially, became armour bearer, played with his harp 16:21-23
- Battle with the Philistines 1 Sam 17
- Too young for battle 17:13,14, youth 17:33, stripling 17:56
- Jesse's instructions 17:17
- David's obedience 17:20
- Troubled that someone should defy God's people 17:26
- Falsely accused 17:28
- Trusted the Lord because of his help in the past 17:34-37
- Gave the Lord glory 17:46,47
- David behaved himself wisely 18:5
