- End of the Gospels – Jesus' death and resurrection.
- Acts 1:8,9 – Jesus promised the Holy Ghost would come; Command to be witnesses; Jesus ascends
- 1:10,11 – Promise of Jesus' return
- 2:1-11 – Holy Spirit comes on day of Pentecost
- 2:14, 21 – Peter's message
- 2:38,39 – Salvation also for children
- 2:47 – Many were getting saved
- Ch3 – Peter and John heal the lame man
- Ch4 – Peter and John arrested because of the miracle
- 4:21,22 – Let go
- 5:17-20 – Imprisoned and set free by the angel
- 5:40-42 – Beaten, let go, kept preaching.
- 9:36-42 – Dorcas restored to life
- 12:1-4 – Wicked Herod kills James and intends to do the same with Peter.
- 12:5-11 – Miraculous release as a result of prayer
- 12:12,13 – Rhoda prayed; attentive to knock
- 12:14 – Told others of answer to prayer
- 12:15 – Rhoda believed (constantly affirmed that it was so). The others didn't believe. They suggested a story which was just as unbelievable.
- 12:16 – Rhoda was glad (had assurance of God's answer). The others were astonished (surprised).
- 12:17-19 – Paul departs. Prison keepers put to death.
- 12:21-23 – Herod's death
- 12:24 – The Word of God grew and multiplied.
