Abraham's Children

- God asked Abram to leave his country, house and family and go to a place that God would show him. Gen 12:1
- God gave Abram promises. Gen. 12:2,3 & Gen 15:3-6
- Failing to trust God. Ishmael born. Gen. 16:1-3, 15-16
- Abram's name changed to Abraham. Promises given again. Gen. 17:1-8
- Sarai's name changed to Sarah. Promise of a son. Gen. 17:15-21
- Mention visit from the Lord. (What did they eat?) Sarah laughed. Gen 18:1, 10-15
- Isaac born. (The first star or grain of sand) Gen 21:1-7
- Hagar and Ishmael cast out. Gen 21:8-21
- Abraham's test. Gen 22:1-10
- God is pleased and provides a ram. Gen. 22:11-13
- God's promises again. Gen. 22:15-18
- Abraham was considered righteous because of his faith – He believed God.

New Memory Verse

He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness. (Rom 4:20-22)
