John's Advice to Children

- Many times in 1 John, John writes particularly to little children. These children have trusted Christ as their Saviour.
- 1 John 2:12,13 Their sins are forgiven. They knew God.
- Do you know God? John talks about Jesus being the Good Shepherd. John 10:11. God knows His sheep and they know Him. John 10:14. He gives His sheep eternal life. John 10:27,28
- 1 John 2:1,2 I write these things to you so that you do not sin. If you do sin, Christ is your advocate (intercessor, goes between you and God, on your behalf). He is the propitiation (accepting our punishment) for our sins and the whole world's.
- 1 John 2:18, 22 It is the last time and there are antichrists – they deny that Jesus is the Christ.
- 1 John 2:21,24a Let the truth that you have known abide (stay, remain, dwell) in you.
- 1 John 2:28-3:3 Jesus is coming. He shall appear. Don't be ashamed. Purify yourselves. We shall be like Him. Titus 2:11-13 Looking for that blessed hope.
- 1 John 3:7,10 Don't be deceived (tricked). Those who do not righteousness or love his brother are not of God.
- 1 John 3:11,18 Love one another. Not in word but in deed (actions) and truth (genuine).
- 1 John 4:4 Be an overcomer. Greater is He that is in you than Satan.
- 1 John 5:21 Keep yourselves from idols. What is an idol? 1 Thess. 1:9,10 Give God first place and be ready for His coming.
