- Jesus care, healing, and teaching 6:34, See Matt. 14:14
- Evening, Matt. 14:15 & Mark 6:35 (People must have been so occupied that they did not realise the time nor their stomachs)
- Problem – no food. 6:36,37
- A boy's lunch. John 6:8,9
- Matt. 14:17 “..Bring them hither to me.”
- People sat down in companies. Jesus blessed and brake. Mark 6:39-41
- All satisfied with leftovers. Mark 6:42-44
- Matthew 14:21 – 5000 men beside women and children
- What would have it been like to be that boy? What a story to tell. He would have no doubt of Jesus' power.
