Jairus' Daughter - Life from the Lord

- Widow's son raised to life. Luke 7:11-17
- Rumours of Jesus spread. V.17
- List of what Jesus had done. V.22
- Many people waiting and welcoming Jesus as He returned from the Gadarene's country.
- Jairus a ruler of the synagogue, a man of faith fell at Jesus' feet, besought Him, "she shall live" Luke 8:41, Mark 5:22.23
- Daughter ruler's daughter, only child, dying. Luke 8:42, Mark 5:30
- Woman touched Jesus and was healed. Mark 5:30
- News that daughter was dead. Mark 5:35
- Jesus comforts. "Be not afraid, only believe." Mark 5:36
- Jesus' touched her (compare with woman who touched Jesus strength). Jesus' word powerful. Mark 5:41
- Astonished greatly (amazed) Mark 5:42
- Told not to tell anyone. Mark 5:43. The news spread. Matthew 9:26
- Jesus' care "...give her food." Mark 5:43
- The daughter learned that God is the giver of life. She was given extra life because of the faith of her father. She had the privilege of being touched by the Lord. She experienced His care. Even though they were not to tell anyone, her life was living proof of God's power.
- Let us not forget that every breath that we take is from the Lord, He cares and provides for our needs, He wants to be close to us. "Draw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you..." James 4:8
- If we find ourselves in a scary place, remember "be not afraid, only believe" We have an all powerful God.
