- The boy with a spirit. 9:14-18, See Matt. 17:15
- Disciples could not cure him. 9:18
- Read 9:19-22a. Mention the danger the child was in.
- The father's small faith. 9:22b-24
- Jesus heals the boy. 9:25-27, See Matt. 17:18
- Why could the disciples not cast him out? 9:28, Matt. 17:19-21
- Faith as a grain of mustard seed. Where Bible mentions "O ye of little faith", little faith means incredulous, that is lacking confidence (in Christ). Incredulous in the dictionary means, "(of a person or their manner) unwilling or unable to believe something."
- Discuss fasting.
- Talk about the new life the boy had.
- Hebrews 11:6
