- Genesis to 2 Kings

The Brave, Tenderhearted King

- Coming judgment on Judah. 2 Kings 21:12-15
- Eight year old Josiah reigned in Jerusalem for 31 years. 2 Chron.34:1
- Did right in the sight of the Lord. Walked in the ways of David and declined not to the right or left. 34:2 (Prov 4:25-27) He did this even with all the great wickedness going on around him.
- At 16 years old, he began to seek (follow) after God. 34:3
- At 20 years old, he purged Judah and Jerusalem and beyond (Israel) from idols and wicked priests. 34:3-7
- At 26 years old, he sent people to repair the temple. 34:8 (v.9-14)
- While repairing the temple, the book of the law was found. 34:15. If you seek God you will find Him. Deut 4 (esp v.29)
- Repentant (wanted to change) 34:19
- Tender heart (soft heart). Humble (subjection, bow the knee) before God. 34:27 Humble yourself before God and He shall lift you up. James 4:10
- Read God's word to all the people, made decision to serve God, and made all the people serve God. 34:30-33
- Judah still doomed for destruction. 2 Kings 23:26,27
- Jehoahaz, Josiah's son reigned for 3 months and Pharaoh took him. 2 Chron. 36:4
- Jehoiakim, Josiah's son reigned 11 years, paying tribute to Pharaoh and being overrun by enemies. 2 Kings 24:2
- Jehoiachin, Jehoiakim's son, reigned 3 months and went into captivity to Babylon. The exile.
