- Genesis to Ruth

Don't Forget

- Children need to hear of God's wonderful works, His strength, His praises. Why? See Psalm 78:1-8
- to tell their children, to keep God's commandment, to trust God, to not be stubborn and rebellious, to not forget His works
- What things did God do for the children of Israel? Ps. 78:13, 14, 16, 24, 25, 43, 52
- The children of Israel did forget His works Ps. 78:10-11, 32, 42
- They must have failed to obey the instructions in Deut. 6:1-7
- Joshua – book of conquering the promised land.
- Judges – sad cycles of children of Israel doing what was right in their own eyes.
- Hebrews 11:32 reminds us that even though the majority of the people were doing their own thing, there were some such as Gideon, Barak, Samson, and Jephthah who did have faith in God.
- Ruth, who was not an Israelite but a Moabite, also trusted in the Lord. Ruth 1:16, 2:12. She married a godly Israelite man and had a baby named Obed. Obed was the grandfather of David.

New Memory Verse
